Dear Fellow Servants of God:

*I am writing this letter as Global Connection International completes its tenth year. We are rejoicing and praising God for all that has been accomplished, for the many countries and projects that the Lord has opened. We are in awe of all that God has done through Global Connection -- none of which would be possible without your prayers and support.*

*As we enter 2010 and the start of another decade of Global Connection, we are particularly excited about some of the new projects taking place and our desire to start this year in a strong financial position.*

*Some of our most pressing projects include:*

*1. **Expansion of the Blessed Are The Children Fund.** Since we started the Blessed Are The Children's Fund in 2007, where we come along side churches and pastors to help care for the poorest of the poor children. We are also supporting orphanages, feeding programs and ministries to street kids in many places. These programs are being carried out in Cambodia, Nicaragua, Guatemala, Honduras, Cuba and Tanzania. There are additional countries and projects for the poorest of the poor kids that we would like to expand.*

*2. **In January we will start construction of the second Susie Syke Medical Clinic and Learning Center in Moshi, Tanzania.** This will cost \$35,000.00 to build and another \$15,000.00 for the first year operating costs totaling \$50,000.00. We have raised \$15,000.00 of this so far. The center will be a community development project. We have seen great impact in El Crucero, Nicaragua where the Susie Syke Clinic has been a center for not only meeting medical needs, but also caring for women and children and teaching life and business skills. As we minister to the poorest of the poor their hearts become open to the message of Christ.*


*3. **The aprende/Logos Resource Centers.** Next month a team will be traveling to Cuba to establish learning/resource centers for House Church Pastors. The centers will also be established in eight (8) Seminaries. The computer centers will have CD materials equivalent to a mini-Bible School. This style of training will be much cheaper and more efficient than shipping books into the country. We will need funds to purchase Computers and Printers.*

*As we enter a new decade for Global Connection, we will need your prayer and financial support for the many projects going on. And possibly you might consider traveling with us to see firsthand what we are doing.*

*Your continued support will allow us to co-labor for the kingdom of God with national church leaders in difficult countries.*
